Course Title: Social Studies

Course Description: The course is divided into ten units. They are United States, Canada, South America, Europe, Russia, Asia, Africa, Southeast Asia, The Pacific World and Antarctica. In addition the students complete two projects. The format is lecture, discussion based on text.
